Declaration of Conformity with California Proposition 65

Dear Sir or Madam,

We hereby declare that our company is aware of the requirements set forth under **California Proposition 65**, also referred to as the *Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986*, and has incorporated relevant compliance considerations into its internal regulatory processes.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide a clear and reasonable warning to consumers in California **if exposure to any listed chemical occurs in the course of product use**, and if such exposure exceeds the applicable **Safe Harbor Level**, unless a specific exemption applies. The list of chemicals is maintained by the **California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA)** and includes substances known to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive toxicity.

To the best of our current knowledge, and based on information provided by our suppliers, **no exposure to listed substances resulting from our products has been identified that would trigger a Proposition 65 warning**.

This declaration is made voluntarily and does not constitute a legally binding warranty. It reflects the current regulatory framework, our internal assessments, and supplier-provided data. Comprehensive testing of all material constituents is not feasible in every case. Regulatory requirements and substance listings are subject to change at any time.

We continuously monitor updates to the OEHHA chemical list and assess new regulatory developments accordingly.
