Declaration of TSCA Regulatory Compliance

Dear Sir or Madam,

On January 6, 2021, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued its final rules under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals (see table below). The purpose of these regulations is to reduce the exposure risk to humans and the environment from these hazardous substances:

| • Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd) | (CAS No. 87–68–3) |
| • Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) | (CAS No. 133-49-3) |
